





DATO DR YC LEE, Malaysia

Dato Dr Y C Lee, trained in the Moorfields Eye Hospital and is renowned for his surgical innovations in the management of complicated cataracts. Founder and Chairman of Lee Eye Centre, he is currently the Medical Superintendent of Perak Community Specialist Hospital. He has received numerous awards, the most recent being the Refractive Surgery (ASCRS) Honoured Guest Award (2017).

Dr Fam Han Bor, Senior Consultant, Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore, completed his fellowship in Cornea & Refractive Surgery at the University of British Columbia, Vancouver, Canada. Dr Fam is active in the teaching of refractive and cataract surgery, with interest in corneal topography, visual optics and wavefront sciences.



DR. ARUP CHAKRABARTI, India


