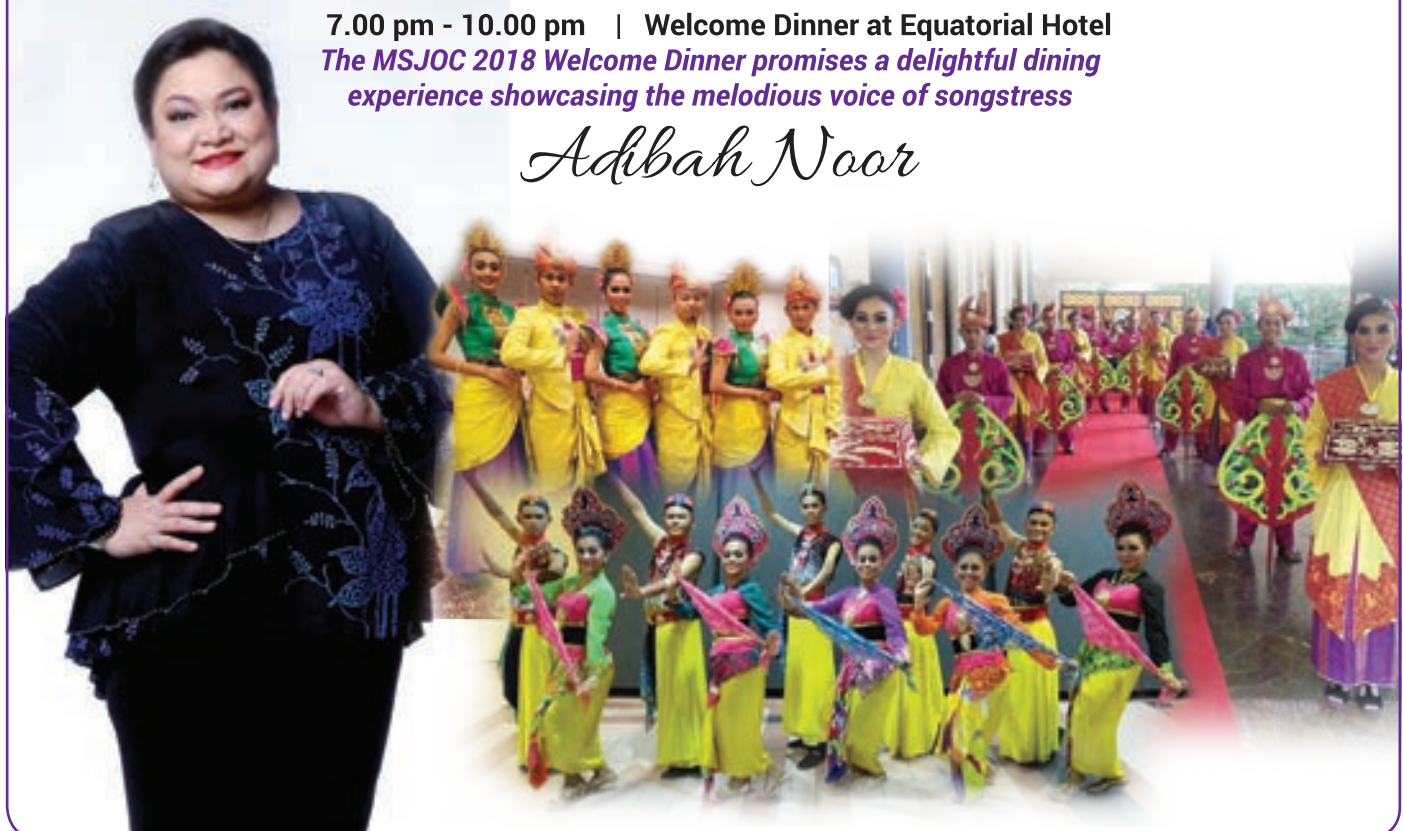

Dato Dr YC Lee, trained in the Moorfields Eye Hospital and is renowned for his surgical innovations in the management of complicated cataracts. 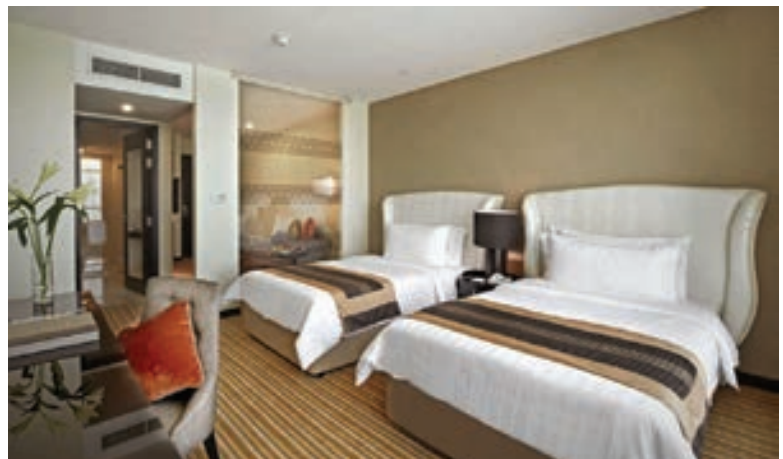
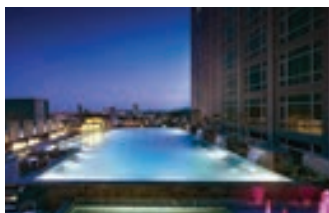
